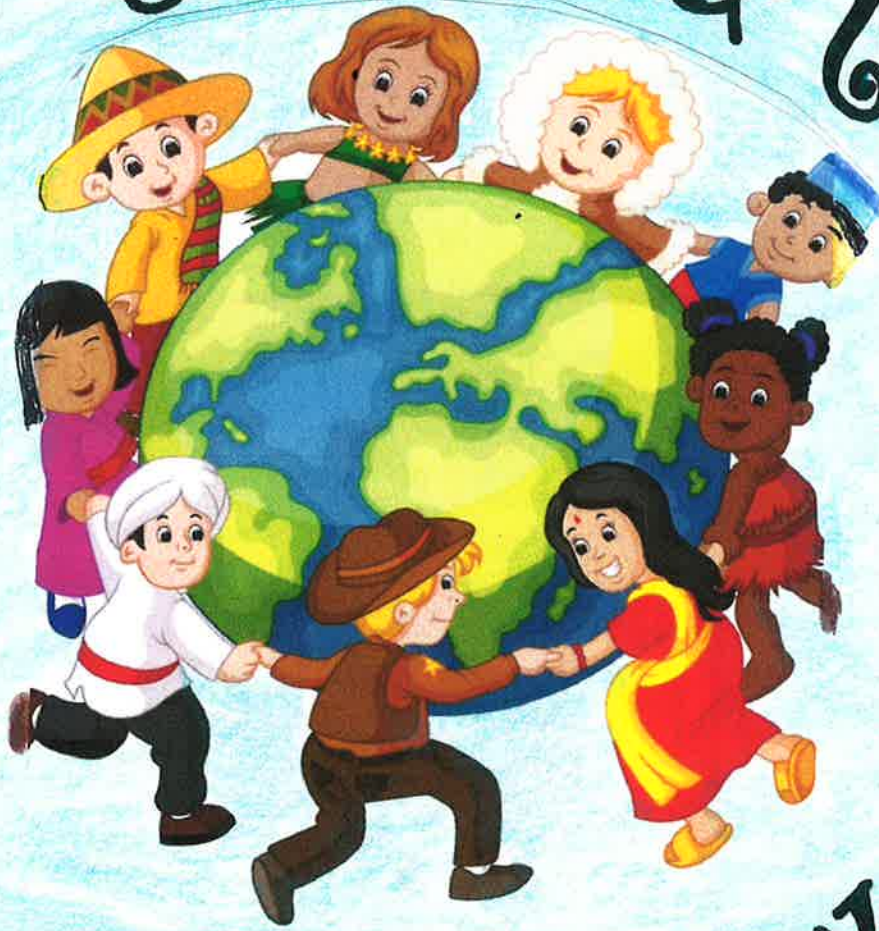


Global
