Then Whale replied, "We could use those jars with stickers." (which were milk jugs.)

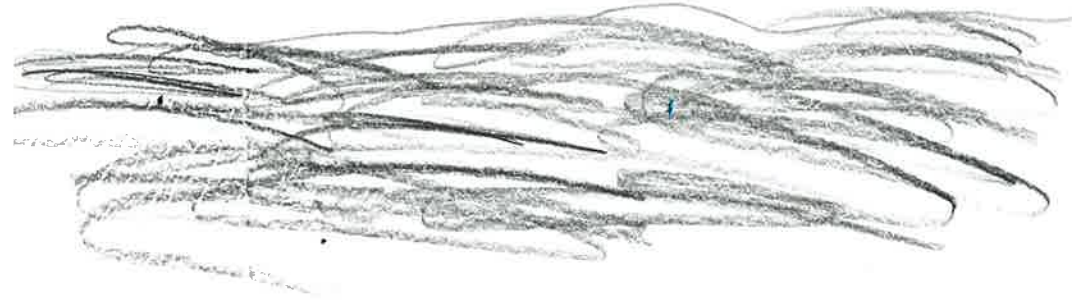
"Okay let's start!" said Jellyfish.
