

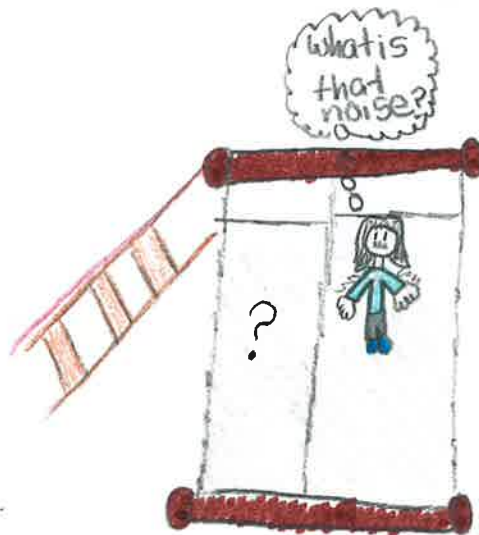


The Creepy Footsteps

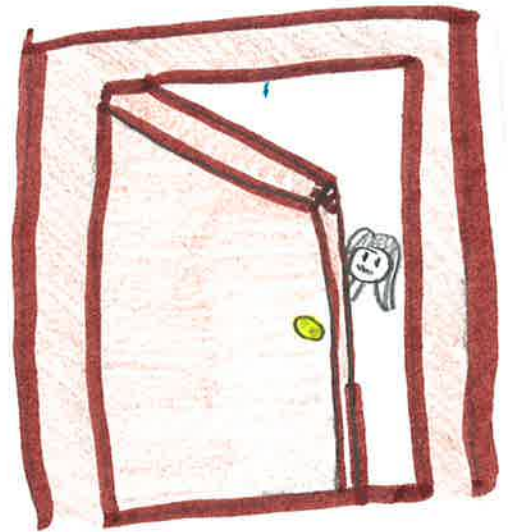

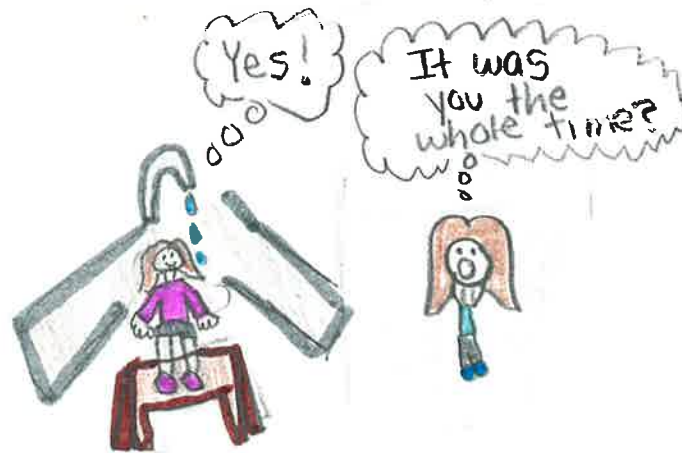
"What could that noise be?" I whispered to myself. I quietly walked out of my bed to check what that annoying noise was. After
