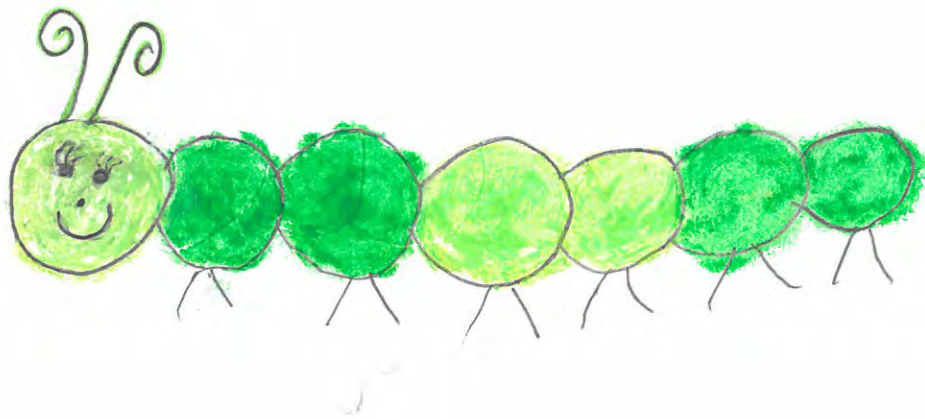


Maya the curious
caterpillar

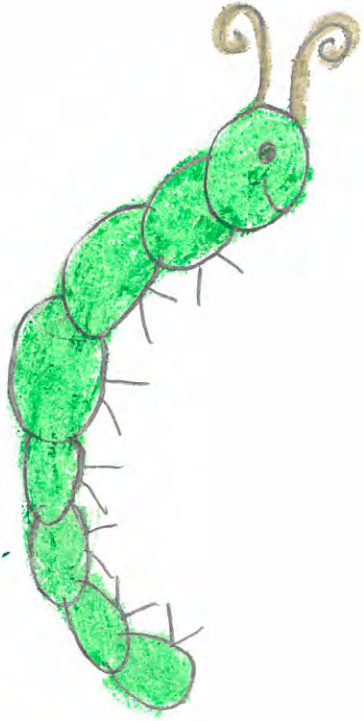

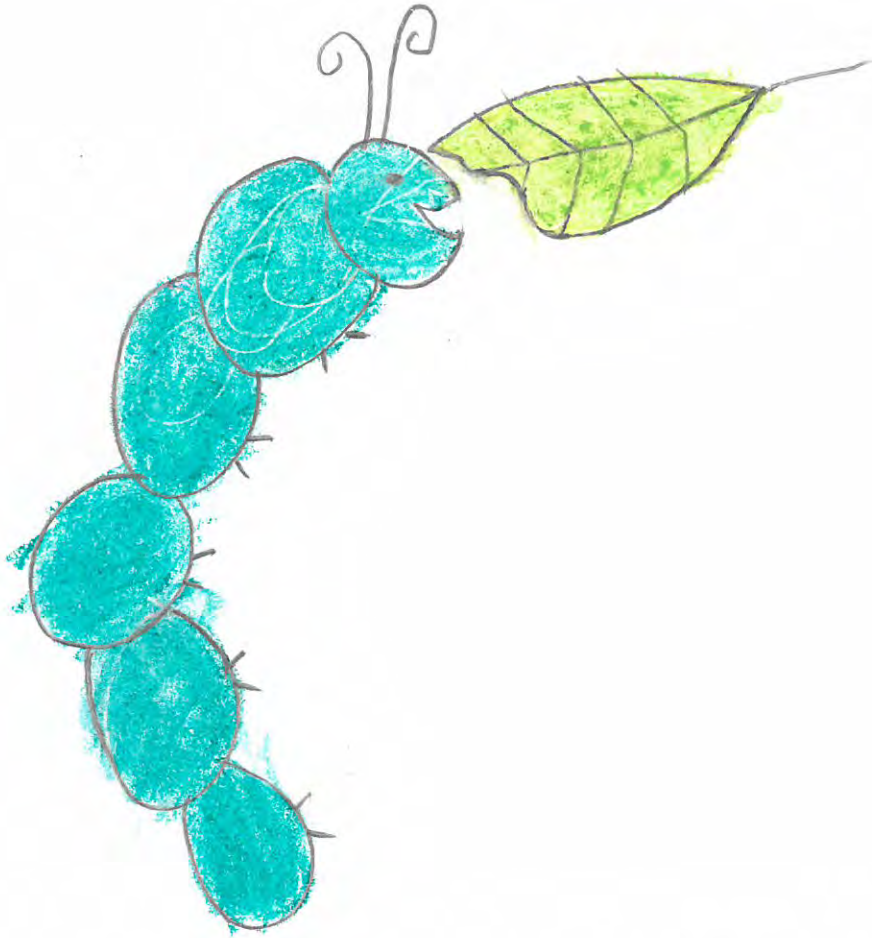
